GUARDRAIL REPAIR & REPLACEMENT
CONTRACT #11-16

1. General

1.1 Summary

- A. The Rhode Island Turnpike and Bridge Authority (the Authority) is soliciting proposals from qualified professional vendors to repair and replace metal guardrail sections and associated structures on Authority property located in the towns of Jamestown, Portsmouth and Bristol.

2. Requirements

2.1 Services Required

- A. The bidder will be required to repair and/or replace guardrail systems on Authority property to the specifications as noted in the “Rhode Island Standard Details” from the Rhode Island Department of Transportation.
- B. The bidder will be required to have a temporary traffic control zone that complies with the latest edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD). A certified flagger will be part of the temporary traffic control zone.
- C. Upon notification by the Authority, the bidder will repair and/or replace the guardrail within fourteen (14) calendar days.

3. General Terms and Conditions

3.1 Receipt and Opening of Proposals

- A. Sealed Bids (Proposals) will be accepted and time stamped upon receipt in the office of the Executive Director at One East Shore Road, Jamestown, Rhode Island, 02835 until 3:00 p.m., Friday, January, 20, 2012. Two (2) copies of the proposal must be submitted in a sealed envelope marked “Guardrail Replacement and Repair” – Contract #11-16. Bids will be opened publicly and read at the Authority’s office on Friday, January, 20, 2012 at 3:00 p.m..

3.2 Form of Bid

- A. Bidders shall submit two (2) copies of their bid on the form provided, with supplemental information, and other required documentation, literature and material to be provided with the bid, on the bidders own form.
- B. On the proposal form provided, provide the quantity price options as noted.

- C. As part of the bid, also provide an agreement on the provided form on the adherence to the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) in establishing a temporary traffic control zone during repairs.

3.3 Submission of Bids

- A. Envelopes containing bids must be sealed and must be plainly marked with the name and address of the bidder and plainly marked as “Guardrail Replacement and Repair”, Contract #11-16. Bids shall be delivered or mailed to:

- B. Any bidder may withdraw his bid by written request at any time prior to the advertised time for opening. Telephone, email and or fax bids, amendments, or withdrawals will not be accepted.
- C. Unless otherwise specified, no bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days from time of bid opening without the permission of the Executive Director.
- D. Negligence on the part of the bidder in preparing the bid confers no rights for the withdrawal of the bid after it has been opened.
- E. Proposals received prior to the time of opening will be securely kept, unopened. No responsibility will be attached to an officer or person for the premature opening of a proposal not properly addressed and identified.
- F. Any deviation from the specifications must be noted in writing and attached as part of the bid proposal. The bidder shall indicate the item or part with the deviation and indicate how the bid will deviate from specifications.
- G. Include in the bid paperwork a completed W-9 Form which is attached.

3.4 Rhode Island Sales Tax:

- A. The authority is exempt (certificate # 984) from the payment of the Rhode Island Sales Tax under the 1956 General Laws of the State of Rhode Island, 44-18-30, Paragraph I, as amended.

3.5 Federal Excise Taxes:

- A. The authority is exempt from the payment of any excise tax or federal transportation taxes. The price bid must be exclusive of taxes and will be so construed.

3.6 Qualification of Bidders:

- A. The Authority may make such investigations as it deems necessary to determine the quality and ability of the bidder to perform the work. The bidder shall furnish the Authority with all such information and data for the purpose as may be requested.
- B. The bidder shall provide three (3) references on Attachment.

3.7 Addenda and Interpretations:

3.8 Award of Bids:

- A. The Authority reserves the right to award in whole or in part.

3.9 Contract Term:

- A. This is a one year contract with two additional one year options to renew.

3.10 Hold Harmless:

- A. The contractor shall be responsible for his work and every part thereof, and for all materials, tools, appliances, and property of every description used in connection therewith. The contractor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Rhode Island Turnpike and Bridge Authority, its employees and agents, against loss or expense by reason of the liability imposed by law upon the contractor, all sub-contractors, or owner for damage because of bodily injuries, including person or persons or on account of damage to property arising out of or in consequence of the performance of this work whether such injuries to persons or damage to property are due or claimed to be due to any negligence, including gross negligence, of a sub-contractor, the owner, the general contractor, his or their employees or agents, or any other person.

3.11 Deadline for Submissions of Proposals

- A. The sealed bids will be accepted until 3:00 p.m., Friday, January, 20, 2012 at the office of the Authority, One East Shore Road, Jamestown, Rhode Island. Two (2) copies of the proposal must be submitted in a sealed envelope marked "Guardrail Replacement and Repair" – Contract #11-16 and may be mailed to the Authority or hand carried and delivered to the Authority prior by the time and date noted above. Bids will be opened publicly and read at the Authority's office on Friday, January, 20, 2012 at 3:00 p.m.
- B. The authority reserves the right to reject any or all bids, waive any informality in the bidding, or accept the bid deemed to be in the best interest of the Authority.

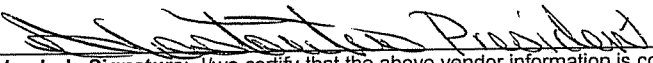

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General Instructions

Section references are to the Internal Revenue Code unless otherwise noted.

Purpose of Form

A person who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) to report, for example, income paid to you, real estate transactions, mortgage interest you paid, acquisition or abandonment of secured property, cancellation of debt, or contributions you made to an IRA.

Use Form W-9 only if you are a U.S. person (including a resident alien), to provide your correct TIN to the person requesting it (the requester) and, when applicable, to:

- Certify that the TIN you are giving is correct (or you are waiting for a number to be issued),
- Certify that you are not subject to backup withholding, or
- Claim exemption from backup withholding if you are a U.S. exempt payee. If applicable, you are also certifying that as a U.S. person, your allocable share of any partnership income from a U.S. trade or business is not subject to the withholding tax on foreign partners' share of effectively connected income.

Note. If a requester gives you a form other than Form W-9 to request your TIN, you must use the requester's form if it is substantially similar to this Form W-9.

Definition of a U.S. person. For federal tax purposes, you are considered a U.S. person if you are:

- An individual who is a U.S. citizen or U.S. resident alien,
- A partnership, corporation, company, or association created or organized in the United States or under the laws of the United States,
- An estate (other than a foreign estate), or
- A domestic trust (as defined in Regulations section 301.7701-7).

Special rules for partnerships. Partnerships that conduct a trade or business in the United States are generally required to pay a withholding tax on any foreign partners' share of income from such business. Further, in certain cases where a Form W-9 has not been received, a partnership is required to presume that a partner is a foreign person, and pay the withholding tax. Therefore, if you are a U.S. person that is a partner in a partnership conducting a trade or business in the United States, provide Form W-9 to the partnership to establish your U.S. status and avoid withholding on your share of partnership income.
