

POSITION: PAINT MANAGER/FOREMAN

The Rhode Island Turnpike and Bridge Authority (“Authority”), a quasi-public agency, seeks to hire a Paint Manager/Foreman. The position of Paint Manager/Foreman will be responsible for:

- Managing the day to day painting operations within the RITBA Maintenance Department. This includes assessing equipment, materials and labor needed to complete routine painting activities for the purpose of ensuring that painting projects meet RITBA standards.
- Assists in the selection of training and in-service programs for maintenance staff, for the purpose of conveying information and ensuring that staff gain and maintain a thorough understanding of safety regulations and RITBA policies/procedures.
- Collaborates with RITBA department heads and vendors for the purpose of implementing and maintaining service and/or programs.
- Coordinates the service and activities of outside contractors as assigned for the purpose of ensuring contracted work is accomplished in a safe, effective and timely manner that meets RITBA standards and objectives.
- Maintains a variety of manual and electronic files and/or records for the purpose of providing up-to-date reference and compliance with regulatory and established guidelines.
- Maintains assigned Authority tools, supplies, equipment and vehicle(s) for the purpose of ensuring their availability as needed to meet assigned maintenance objectives.
- Prioritizes and assigns painting related activities to maintenance staff for the purpose of ensuring that RITBA locations are maintained in a safe working environment that meets budget targets and Authority guidelines.

Candidates will be evaluated based on meeting some or all of the following criteria:

- NACE Level 2 Coating Inspector Certification
- SSPC C-3 Supervisor/Competent Person Certification for Deleading Industrial Structures
- SSPC Bridge Coating Inspector Level 1 Certification
- Fall Protection Training
- Confined Space Training
- A valid commercial driver’s license
- Experience operating a UBIU (snooper)
- Knowledge of Word and Excel

- A minimum of 5 years of experience with the planning, surface preparation and coating of complex bridge structures
- Previous experience supervising staff
